

# SUN CATCHER PRODUCT KIT

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## Introduction

These instructions will walk you through how to assemble a sun catcher. You can take what you learn here to create new products, like window clings, vehicle decor, and ornaments! hope that you enjoy this project. Make sure that you have received all of the materials necessary to create your product. Especially your survey sheet, which you should have already completed.

Now ready your workspace to ensure an enjoyable and efficient production.  
Is your space large enough? Has it been wiped clean?

## Materials

- Wide Mouth Mason Jar Rings
- Color Pencils
- Coloring Pages
- Olive Oil Dropper
- Cotton Balls
- Scissors
- Twine
- Tacky Glue
- Window Cling
- Napkins
- Workspace Preparation Kit
- PPE
- Branding Kit
- Product Bag



## Completion

This kit will make 25 products. You can then sell these items independently, at a SSV Work & Learn Marketplace Event or around your community.

# Steps

**1** Start by selecting a coloring page to color using the color pencils provided. You will need several completed coloring pages to complete the product kit.



**6** Wrap twine around the outside of the mason jar to create the string to hang the catcher in a window. You will need a knot at the lid end, and a second at the end on the window cling.




**2** Once the design is complete, use the metal seal from your mason jar lid to trace a circle to cut your design to fit inside your lid. This will create the sun catcher, so choose your spot carefully by holding your color page up to light before you trace. You may be able to trace multiple circles on one page.



**7** Attach the mason ring to the window cling and package for sale.



**3** Once your trace is complete, you can cut out your design. Make sure that your design fits in the center, before you move on.



**8** Create a personalized label for the outside of your product box. Have fun creating a brand name and business logo for your product. Your labels should include your personal branding. Once your labels have been created, affix them to your product bags to prepare for sale.

**4** Collect your circles on your placemat. Drop some olive oil onto each circle and rub it lightly with a cotton ball. The oil will make your design more transparent. You will need the paper to dry overnight. Flip it over frequently to help with the drying process.



**9** Repeat these steps until you have run out of materials.

**5** Place tacky glue all around the inside of the ring of the mason jar lip. Place your design in the center of the ring and allow the glue to dry.



**10** Complete your post test survey and follow the completion instructions on the front of this sheet.
