

PLANT STICKS STICKS PRODUCT KIT

Introduction

These instructions will walk you through how to create marking sticks. You can take what you learn here to create new products, like table setting markers or food labels! We hope you enjoy this project. Make sure that you have received all of the materials necessary to create your product. Especially your survey sheet, which you should have already completed.

Now ready your workspace to ensure an enjoyable and efficient production. Is your space large enough? Has it been wiped clean?

Materials

- Clay & Tools
- Stamps
- Product Box/Bag
- Product Labels
- Markers
- Aluminum Foil
- Wax Paper Placemat



Completion

This kit will make 25 products. You can then sell these items independently, at a SSV Work & Learn Marketplace Event or around your community.

Steps

 Choose the letters from your stamp set to create different garden sticks. You can make sticks for common house plants, flowers, or herbs. Choose at least three, as this product will contain three different sticks.

Basil



 Allow the baked clay time to cool before removing them from the baking sheet.




 Once the garden sticks are cool to the touch, they can be placed in final packaging.



 Choose the color clay you would like to use for the first set of garden sticks. Roll the clay between your hands to warm up the clay to shape it. You can now shape the clay as you desire. You can mix colors together or create shapes for the top of your stick. Feel free to get creative. You can manipulate the clay until it is baked.



 Create a custom label with your business name to distinguish your products.



 Cut the clay into long pieces to form your stick. Make sure that the pieces are long enough to stamp your label. One end of your clay piece should be tapered to fit into the dirt easily.



 Stamp the sticks to create the labels and place them on a piece of foil or baking rack.



 Repeat these steps until you have run out of materials.

 Bake your clay garden sticks at 210 degrees for ten minutes to set the clay.
