

THREADED BRACELET PRODUCT KIT

Introduction

These instructions will walk you through how to assemble a threaded bracelet. You can take what you learn here to create new products, like braided rugs, embroidery wrapped earrings, and feather necklaces! We hope that you enjoy this project. Make sure that you have received all of the materials necessary to create your product.

Now ready your workspace to ensure an enjoyable and efficient production. Is your space large enough? Has it been wiped clean?

Materials

- Embroidery Thread
- Washi Tape
- Felt Place Mat
- Scissors
- Beads
- Product Packaging
- Hairnets
- Gloves
- Branding Kit
- Tape Measure
- Workspace Preparations



Completion

This kit will make 25 products. You can then sell these items independently, at a SSV Work & Learn Marketplace Event or around your community.


Steps



Clean your work space and lay down the table mat to prepare your space for working. Lay out all of the materials provided and choose three colored cords of embroidery thread to make your first bracelet.




Begin tying your forward knots by creating the number four, by lifting the left most string from the bottom and placing it over the other strings, while using one finger to create a sharp turn in the string. This should create a "four" like shape, as pictured below.



Once you have chosen your three colors, measure out 5 feet of string, for each color, using the tape measure provided. Then line all of the strings up evenly and fold the whole group of strings in half.



Bring the long end of this string under the other colored strings and back through the the "four" loop that you created. When you pull tight, this will create your first knot in the bracelet.



Create a loop for your bracelet by creating a knot in the group of string where it was folded in half.



Do this over and over with the same color and it will begin to twist. Once you have enough of one color, simply move onto the next color string and repeat this process until you have run out of string, or the bracelet is your desired length.



Above your felt placement, on your covered space, using the washi tape provided, tape the top loop of your bracelet to keep it secure and in place while you tie your knots.



Package all of your products and prepare for sale. You should create a brand name for the label on the outside of your bracelets.



Lay out the color pattern you desire with your strings. The felt placemat should help hold them in place while you work. You will begin with the string in the left most position and work left to right.



Complete your post test survey and you can now prepare to sell your product. You can sell these on your own, or back to Street Smart Ventures through your advisor.
